Since 1985, the staff at the Franciscan Spirituality Center has trained more than 400 people in the practice of spiritual direction. This innovative program provides a mix of workshops and real-life experiences to prepare individuals to move into their communities and jobs as trained spiritual directors.

The Spiritual Direction Preparation Program (SDPP) extends over three years, giving participants an opportunity to integrate theory and practice. While the SDPP prepares the participant to direct others regardless of their spirituality, this program teaches from the Judeo-Christian tradition.





General Information

All workshops begin at 7 p.m. Friday and conclude at noon Sunday. The practicum is a six-day workshop that begins at noon Sunday and concludes at noon Saturday.

The program will begin in September 2016. Participants are expected to have a spiritual director by the beginning of the program and make a six-day directed retreat by July 1, 2018. Participants who satisfactorily complete the three-year program will receive a certificate of completion.

Quarterly Meetings with Supervisor

Quarterly meetings are separate from the workshops and last approximately two hours. During the meeting, participants review the required readings and verbatims with their supervisor. In some cases, quarterly meetings can be scheduled off-site and closer to your place of residence. Quarterly meetings are typically scheduled in the months of October, January, April and July.

*Annual Review

In order to integrate the learning and experiences, there is a 90-minute annual review at the end of each program year. The review takes place at the Franciscan Spirituality Center.

Program Fees

\$2,075 per year I & II

\$2,225 year III (includes practicum week)

Fees include tuition for all weekend workshops, six-day practicum in year III, quarterly meetings, annual review with supervisor and all administrative fees, meals and snacks. Fees are payable in installments. Please speak to program co-directors about individual plans. Limited scholarships are available.

Additional Fees

\$84 for housing per workshop and \$250 for housing during the practicum. (Payable at the time of the event.)

Other expenses include the cost of your books, fees for spiritual direction and the required six-day retreat.

About the Program

This program is designed for those who:

- Are older than 30 and are drawn to a deeper understanding of spiritual direction.
- Have not had formal training in spiritual direction.
- Are preparing for a ministry of spiritual or retreat direction and/or the practice of redemptive listening.
- Would like to deepen their spiritual and personal development.

Participants learn by:

- Attending required workshops.
- Practicing direction skills using monthly verbatims.
- Meeting quarterly with a supervisor who is an experienced spiritual director.
- Writing reflection papers on required books and articles.
- Participating in annual reviews.
